Course Description

This is a Thesis of theoretical or empirical research undertaken on a business topic in any one of the areas of study in the MA in Entrepreneurship and Innovation Program. This is expected to be an independent study by the MA Candidates on a topic of their own choice in consultation with the Director of the MA Program. Subsequent to the approval of such a Thesis Proposal, a Thesis Supervisor is appointed from among the MA Faculty members of Intercollege to work closely with the MA Candidate. The Thesis is expected to result in a written report of about 45 - 55 typed pages of text; all appendices, lists and non-text materials are in addition to the above length. Initially, and for the purpose of Proposal approval, the MA Candidate is expected to choose a focused title, to formulate the problem by expressing it in clear and presentable terms, to define the methodology of required research (primary and/or secondary) relevant to the scope of the agreed work, and to establish the framework for the work in the form of a Table of Contents, i.e. a list of chapters and subchapters. In addition, a preliminary list of reference materials (books, articles, journals etc) must be included in the Proposal.

The Thesis counts for 4 credits, which is a substantial portion of the MA degree credits. Therefore, it requires considerable effort and thought. In order to pass the Thesis requirements (oral and written), the MA Candidate needs to obtain a minimum grade of B- or above. Exceptionally good papers can earn a distinction grade of A.
